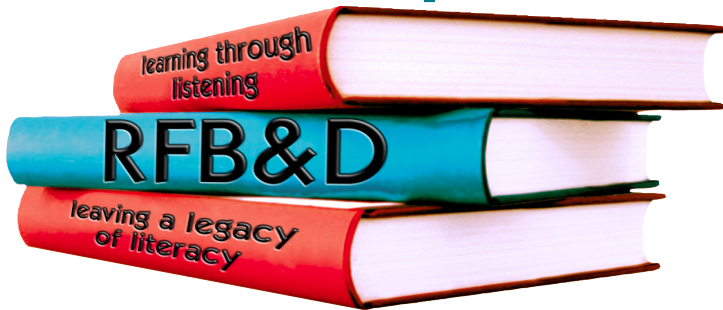


The Arizona Unit of Recording for the Blind & Dyslexic Presents
